



## Quick n' Easy Beanie Hat Knitting Pattern by SuperCrafty.com



The fit of this hat is not too tight, so it won't be sliding up your head. Can be made in solid or stripes, as you please.

**Yarn:** For each color you want in the hat, select 1 skein of Mission Falls 1824 Wool yarn. For a solid color hat, use 2 skeins for women's or men's sizing.

**Gauge:** 18 sts/24 rows per 4"/10cm

**Sizing:** Women's(Men's) For women's hat, approximately 19" circumference fits 21"-24" circumference head. For men's, approximately 21" circumference fits 23"-25" circumference head.

**Tools:** 1 pair size 8 16" circular needles , 1 set size 8 double point needles, or correct size to obtain gauge. Stitch marker, crochet hook and large eye needle to finish and weave in ends.

### Instructions:

- On circular needles, in first color, cast on 86(94) stitches and join to knit in the round. Place stitch marker at start of round.
- \*K1 P1, repeat \* for 1 1/2 inches.
- Switch colors to stripe as you desire. Knit in the round until work measures 6.25"(7") from base, including rib. (Or 2 1/2" shorter than desired length, crown of head to base of ears or at eyebrow level.)
- Start decreasing as follows. Switch to double points when there are too few stitches to fit around the circular needle.
- Round 1: K6, k2tog; repeat to end.
- Rounds 2, 4, 6, 8, 10: Knit.
- Round 3: K5, k2tog; repeat to end.
- Round 5: K4, k2tog; repeat to end.
- Round 7: K3, k2tog; repeat to end.
- Round 9: K2, k2tog; repeat to end.
- Round 11+: \*K1, k2tog: repeat until 8 sts remain.
- Thread large eye needle, sew through remaining stitches and remove from needles. Stitch down through top of hat to secure and to keep from unraveling.
- Finish and weave in ends.
